The Administrative Commission for Glen Burnie/Bridge PC recommends:

- MOTION #19: That Ruling Elders Jihoon Kim and Sung Keun Lee (Bridge Presbyterian Church) be elected to the Administrative Commission.

RATIONALE:

Grace and Peace to you from the Administrative Commission of the Bridge Presbyterian Church (Formerly the Glen Burnie Korean Presbyterian Church).

The Bridge Presbyterian Church Administrative Commission is pleased to report to the Presbytery that Jihoon Kim and Sung Keun Lee were ordained and installed as Elders of Bridge Presbyterian Church on Sunday November 17, 2024, at a 12:30 PM service of worship at First Presbyterian Church of Howard County in the historical sanctuary. We would also report to you that Bridge PC is now worshipping in the First Pres. building at 12:30 PM on Sundays.

The ordination service was a joyful moment for Bridge PC. In attendance were two additional elders from Knox Presbyterian Church for the laying on of hands and members of Bridge and family and friends. We are sincerely grateful to Mt Hebron Church and Pastor Amy Carlson, Transitional Pastor, for their kind hospitality since the sale of the Glen Burnie Korean Presbyterian Church building. They extended the use of their building at a critical time in the life of Bridge. We also are deeply appreciative of the hospitality of 1st Pres. and the assistance of the Rev Ken Page, Interim Pastor of 1st, and several leaders in their church. This change of time and location means worship attendance will likely increase.

We would report to you that the two new elders have taken their training very seriously and were indeed humbled by the weight of the office. Now that two elders have been installed, the Administrative Commission respectfully requests that elders Jihoon Kim and Sung Keun Lee be elected to the Administrative Commission, to work side by side with Pastors Stern, Kim and Ward, and Elder Karen Garret. This would make us a Commission of 6: 3 from Presbytery and 3 from Bridge. Our plan is to walk side by side together for six months and then evaluate whether the Commission can be dissolved. We are hoping that this report can be added to the docket of Thursday's meeting of the Presbytery.
