The number of ruling elders enrolled in the membership of presbytery in 2024 exceeds the number of enrolled ministers and therefore no additional elders from congregations are needed.

Commission on Ministry

The Commission on Ministry reports

That Rev. J.C. Austin was installed as pastor of Woods Memorial Presbyterian on April 27, 2025 at 4PM. The installation commission was comprised of TE John Carlson (chair), TE Mary Speers, TE Nancy Lincoln Reynolds, RE Ellen Ochs, RE Catherine Blacka. The commission was dismissed at the benediction as the end of the service.

At its Leadership Team meeting on April 2,

- It affirmed the policy that churches are to pay an honorarium of \$175 for moderating session meetings. Though the payment cannot be mandated it should be standard practice.
- Reviewed and affirmed the sexual misconduct policy at its provision for placing on unpaid administrative leave those who have not completed the required boundary training in timely fashion
- Approved Woods Memorial's request for permission to form an Associate Pastor Nominating Committee
- Approved the mission study of Christ Memorial Presbyterian and granted permission to form a Pastor Nominating Committee.

At its Credentials meeting on April 28, 2025, approved the transfer of Rev. Gene Gordon (HR) from Carlisle Presbytery.

At its full commission meeting on May 7, 2025,

- approved the retirement of Rev. Theresa Martin-Minnich effective January 31, 2026.
- Approved a waiver of the requirement of participation in a congregation (required of those validated ministries other than congregations) for TE Laurie Hogge through October 2026, while she gets acclimated to being a Presbyterian
- Approved a suggested honorarium of \$50 for TE's and authorized RE's officiating at Communion in a congregation with which they are unaffiliated.
