Called Meeting of Presbytery
February 10, 2022

- The meeting was called by the Moderator, TE Sue Lowcock Harris, on January 20, 2022, to act on motions related to a request to concur with an overture from Giddings-Lovejoy Presbytery, to elect a RE alternate commissioner, to appoint an overture advocate for the overture approved at the October stated meeting, and any other business arising from these matters or other time-sensitive matters related to the 225th General Assembly

- New Business (business related to the 225th GA only) must be given to the Stated Clerk by the time the meeting is called to order.
- New main motions and amendments must be pre-filed in writing with the Stated Clerk
- Minutes of the last stated meeting will be approved at the next stated meeting, March 10, 2022.

Adoption of the Docket

The Stated Clerk recommends:

1. THAT the Docket be approved as printed (and as it may have been modified by announcement of the Moderator and/or Stated Clerk prior to its adoption).

Motions for Action on the Floor of Presbytery

The Commission on Reconciliation recommends:

2. That Presbytery APPROVE concurring with the Overture from Giddings-Lovejoy “to offer *AN APOLOGY TO AFRICAN AMERICANS FOR THE SIN OF SLAVERY AND ITS LEGACY* and to approve the following statements and directives”
3. That Presbytery APPROVE the additional rationale the rationale from Baltimore Presbytery to be included with the original Overture.

The Committee on Representation and Nominations recommends:

4. That Presbytery APPROVE RE E. Joshua Gilhart (First Presbyterian Church, Cumberland) to be alternate ruling elder commissioner to the 225th General Assembly.
