JONGEWAARD SCHOLARSHIP FUND COMMITTEE

Background:

Named for Lawrence H. and Grace K. Jongewaard, who generously placed monies with the Presbyterian Church (USA) Foundation for the purpose of providing scholarship money for active members of the Fallston Presbyterian Church attending seminary. FPC receives only a portion of the earnings from the original gift, which is to be disbursed by the Session of FPC to eligible students. Unused monies have been designated by the trust to be forwarded to Baltimore Presbytery. Monies unused by Baltimore Presbytery shall be returned to the Presbyterian Foundation.

To oversee the distribution of these monies the Session has formed the JONGEWAARD SCHOLARSHIP FUND COMMITTEE with the following form.

I. THE COMMITTEE

- A. The Jongewaard Scholarship Fund Committee shall consist of the following persons:
 - Chairperson of the FPC Christian Education Committee
 - The Treasurer of the Fallston Presbyterian Church
 - The Pastor of the Fallston Presbyterian Church
 - One at-large member of the Session
 - One at-large member of the congregation.
- B. The Committee shall meet once each quarter, following the receipt of funds from the Presbyterian Church (USA) Foundation.
- II. Scholarships shall be rewarded by the committee taking into account the following factors:
 - Demonstrated commitment to the life and mission of FPC
 - The financial need of the applicant
 - Full-time versus part-time academic status
- III. Applicants shall be eligible for scholarship monies if the following criteria are satisfied:
 - must be an active member of FPC
 - must be registered and attending, either full-time or part-time, at an accredited theological institution approved by the Presbytery
 - must preach in the FPC pulpit at least once each year they receive money.
- IV. The scholarship committee shall distribute scholarship monies each quarter as funds are received from the foundation. The committee shall confer with the applicant with regard to how the money shall be distributed.
- V. The Scholarship committee shall report to the Session each quarter as to the status of fund distribution.
