Pulpit Supply List Guidelines

Presbytery of Baltimore
Adopted February 2015, amended November 2022

- A. The Pulpit Supply list for the Presbytery of Baltimore will include the following:
 - 1. Current teaching elders (TE), at their request, in the Presbytery who are either in special ministries or have been honorably retired.
 - 2. Approved Commissioned Ruling Elders (CRE) at their request.
 - 3. Ruling Elders (RE) upon the recommendation of their church's session and pastor.
 - 4. Teaching Elders (TE) from any denomination with whom we are in correspondence provided there is a positive recommendation from that denomination's local authority body. (e.g.: Presbytery, Conference, Bishop)
 - 5. Credentials shall have the authority to approve additional qualified person for inclusion on the Pulpit Supply List.
- B. This list will be the responsibility of Credentials under the direction of and accountable to the Committee on Ministry.
 - 1. An individual wanting his/her name included on the Pulpit Supply List must complete the Pulpit Supply Information Form and forward it to the Office Administrator.
 - 2. The Office Administrator emails a copy to Credentials to review and record.
 - 3. The Office Administrator will select the pertinent information to include on the Pulpit Supply List.

C. Criteria for Removal

- 1. Failure to arrive on time to lead worship and preach. Exceptions: Unexcepted mechanical or weather-related issues that prevent travel.
- 2. Personal or family emergency: The preacher should contact the church's clerk of session or another officiating person as quickly as possible so replacement can be secured.
- 3. Allegations: If a church has complaints, it will be brought to the attention of Credentials, the COM, the session, and the preacher involved for resolution.
- D. It is Credentials responsibility to request the Office Administrator to email the Pulpit Supply List Yearly Update Form to those on the Pulpit Supply List on or about October 1 to be returned to the Office Administrator by October 31.
